PARTICIPATION

While there is great flexibility in how each Council member meets the above expectations, generally, participation includes:

- Joining a **monthly call** for updates from the entire Council (1 HR)

- Sponsoring and/or attending the Council's **Annual Gala**
- Participating in **National & Global Human Trafficking Awareness** campaigns (each January and July)
- Creating and implementing an **action plan** for your company, network, or community
